Let us craft a real Czech experience for you at Hilton Prague Old Town and taste local wines, Czech bites and learn more about the Czech cuisine.

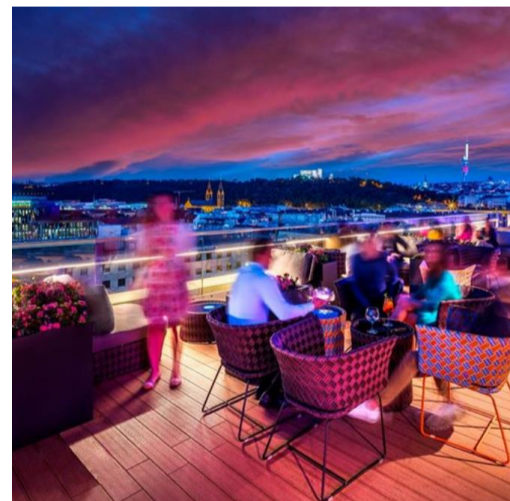
